## MARCH 10 - 11, 2023



### Status of the Ukrainian nuclear power plants and the nuclear industry of Ukraine

- According to SE "NNEGC "Energoatom", as of March 10 - 11, 2023, 9 power units of Ukrainian nuclear power plants, which are located on the territory controlled by Ukraine, worked to meet the needs of the population and the country's economy.

### Current situation on Zaporizhzhya NPP

- According to the SE "NNEGC "Energoatom" as of evening March 10 - 11, 2023, the Zaporizhzhya NPP received power for its in-house needs from the energy system of Ukraine. The radiation situation at the ZNPP site remains normal.
- There is an unauthorized change in the design state of nuclear installations at ZNPP. The Russian occupiers illegally interfere with the operation of heat and power supply systems and build unknown structures near the reserve power plant of power unit No. 6 - Chairman of the State Nuclear Regulatory Inspectorate of Ukraine Oleg Korikov reports. He noted that it is still unrealistic to estimate the amount of damage caused by the occupation - it will be shown by the examination after the de-occupation. However, the risk of decommissioning due to the damage caused by the occupiers is out of the question now.

### Current situation on Chernobyl NPP and in the Exclusion Zone

- On March 10 - 11, 2023, the radiation situation at the ChNPP site was without changes. The monitored parameters of the equipment were within the boundaries set by the technological regulations. Operating personnel continues to ensure nuclear and radiation safety.

### War in Ukraine

- The 381 day of the resistance of Ukraine to the Russian military invasion has ended.
- According to the General Staff of the Armed Forces of Ukraine, over the course of the past 24 hours, enemy forces carried out 29 airstrikes and 4 missile strikes, as well as 100 attacks using multiple-launch rocket systems (MLRS). There are civilian casualties; civilian infrastructure and residential buildings sustained damage.
- Russian forces are continuing their attempts to advance as far as the administrative borders of Donetsk and Luhansk oblasts [eastern Ukraine]. They are focusing their main efforts on offensive operations on the Lyman, Bakhmut, Avdiivka, Marinka and Shakhtarsk fronts. Ukrainian soldiers repelled over 100 enemy attacks on those fronts over the course of the past 24 hours.
- The Russian invaders have suffered significant losses near Avdiivka, Marinka, and

Vuhledar in Donetsk Oblast, so a russian offensive on Vuhledar is currently out of question - spokesman for the joint press office of the Armed Forces of the Tavia front.

- There were no significant changes on the northern fronts. There was no evidence that Russia was forming offensive units in those areas [in northern Ukraine]. Still, Russian forces are continuing to set up positions in parts of Bryansk and Kursk oblasts (Russia) near the border with Ukraine. They deployed mortars and artillery to fire on areas Chernihiv, Sumy and Kharkiv Oblast.
- On the Zaporizhzhya and Kherson fronts, the Russians conducted defensive operations.
- The command of the Armed Forces of the Russian Federation is carrying out measures aimed at simulating a significant increase in its forces and means on the southern front on the territory of the temporarily occupied Zaporizhzhya Oblast. At the same time, it is emphasised that these measures are complex, as they are carried out at the level of demonstration actions with the involvement of military technology and a significant increase in the activity of the occupying forces in the media space of the temporarily occupied territories.
- As of the morning of Saturday, 11 March, the power grid is being restored after a 15th large-scale missile attack and 18th drone attack, with network limitations in place in Zhytomyr Oblast and in some areas of Kharkiv, Dnipro and Mykolaiv oblasts. The Russian attack on Ukraine's energy infrastructure on Thursday, 9 March, damaged three DTEK Energo [the largest private investor in Ukraine's power systems] thermal power plants.
- Russian invaders hit the city of Kherson on the morning of 11 March, causing fatalities. Three civilians were killed as a result of an enemy shell hitting a supermarket.
