## Status of the Ukrainian nuclear power plants and the nuclear industry of Ukraine

- According to SE NNEGC Energoatom, as of July 26, 2023, power units of Ukrainian nuclear power plants, which are located on the territory controlled by Ukraine, worked to meet the needs of the population and the country's economy.

### Current situation on Zaporizhzhya NPP

- According to the SE NNEGC Energoatom as of July 26, 2023, the Zaporizhzhya NPP received power for its in-house needs from the energy system of Ukraine. As of 08:00 on July 26, 2023, the radiation state at the Zaporizhzhya NPP is within the current norms.
- SE NNEGC Energoatom reports that as of 09:00 on July 26, a slight water level decrease in the ZNPP cooling pond remains unchanged. It is currently 16.34 m.

### Current situation on Chornobyl NPP and in the Exclusion Zone

- On July 26, 2023, the radiation situation at the ChNPP site was without changes. The monitored parameters of the equipment were within the boundaries set by the technological regulations. Operating personnel continues to ensure nuclear and radiation safety.

## War in Ukraine

- July 26 is the 516 day of the resistance of Ukraine to the Russian military invasion has ended.
- According to the General Staff of the Armed Forces of Ukraine, during the past day, Russian forces tried to regain lost positions in the area of the settlement Staromaiorske in Donetsk Oblast [eastern Ukraine], but without any success. Heavy fighting is going on, as Russian forces are suffering losses and pulling up their reserves. The defence forces of Ukraine are conducting offensives on the Bakhmut, Melitopol and Berdiansk fronts [eastern Ukraine].
- In total, 28 combat clashes took place at the front.
- On the northern fronts, Russian forces kept their military presence. They fired from mortars and artillery on over 25 settlements.
- In the south, on the Zaporizhzhya and Kherson fronts, Russian forces are focusing their efforts on preventing Ukrainian forces from advancing further. Meanwhile, Ukraine's defence forces continued to conduct offensive operations on the Melitopol and Berdiansk fronts, where they are consolidating the positions they had previously captured and inflicting fire damage.
- Over the past day, Ukrainian aircraft carried out 11 strikes on areas where Russian

military manpower, weapons and equipment were concentrated, and two more on its anti-aircraft missile systems.

- Over the past 24 hours, russian forces launched 49 missile and 37 air strikes, and fired from multiple-launch rocket systems on the positions of Ukrainian troops and settlements 63 times, causing casualties among the civilians and destroying residential buildings. At night, russia attacked Ukraine with UAVs and missiles, air defense forces destroyed 8 "Shaheds".
- An air-raid warning was issued in several oblasts on the night of 26-27 July due to the threat of russian drones and missiles being launched.
- The russian occupiers launched a missile attack on port infrastructure of Odesa region on the night of July 26-27, killing a security guard.
- On the night of July 26-27, the russian army attacked Nikopol district seven times and attacked Dnipropetrovsk Oblast with a drone that was shot down by the defenders. The attack damaged an educational institution, an administrative building, a communications company, a post office and a church. In addition, two 2-storey buildings and an outbuilding were damaged. Power transmission lines were damaged, too.
- russian cruise missiles that were launched on Ukraine on Wednesday evening, in particular, targeted Starokostiantyniv, Khmelnytskyi Oblast. There is a military airfield in Starokostiantyniv. The Air Force reported that at about 19:00, the russian invaders took MiG-31K fighter jets into the sky; they fired four Kh-47 Kinzhal hypersonic missiles towards Khmelnytskyi Oblast. As a result of the shooting down of the missiles, debris fell in populated areas of the Khmelnytskyi district on the territory of a private house.
- Over 180 schools in Ukraine have been completely destroyed, and over 1,300 educational institutions have been damaged due to russia's military aggression - Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine reported.
