Status of the Ukrainian nuclear power plants and the nuclear industry of Ukraine

- According to SE NNEGC Energoatom, as of September 01 – 02, power units of Ukrainian nuclear power plants, which are located on the territory controlled by Ukraine, worked to meet the needs of the population and the country's economy.
- According to SE NNEGC Energoatom, at the end of August, after the repair, a unit of one of the nuclear power plants was connected to the power grid 5 days ahead of schedule. It added 1,000 extra megawatts of power to the grid.

Current situation on Zaporizhzhya NPP

- According to the SE NNEGC "Energoatom" as of September 01 – 02, 2023, the Zaporizhzhya NPP received power for its in-house needs from the energy system of Ukraine. As of 08:00 on September 01 – 02, 2023, the radiation state at the Zaporizhzhya NPP was within the current norms.
- SE NNEGC Energoatom reports that as of 08:00 on September 02, the water level in the cooling pond of Zaporizhzhya NPP was 16.05 m. The situation remains stable and under control.

Current situation on Chernobyl NPP and in the Exclusion Zone

- On September 01 – 02, 2023, the radiation situation at the ChNPP site was without changes. The monitored parameters of the equipment were within the boundaries set by the technological regulations. Operating personnel continues to ensure nuclear and radiation safety.

War in Ukraine

- On September 01, 2023, the 555 day of the resistance of Ukraine to the Russian military invasion has ended.
- According to the Ministry of Defense of Ukraine, Defense forces of Ukraine are conducting offensive operations in the Bakhmut direction [eastern Ukraine].
- The Defense Forces continue to conduct offensive actions south of the city of Bakhmut. Heavy fighting continues in Klishchiivka, Kurdiumivka, Andriivka. There are certain successes, they are fixed at the achieved milestones.
- Active hostilities continue in the Lyman region. Russian troops are trying to attack in the Novoiehorivka and Bilohorivka areas of the Luhansk region.
- Also, Ukrainian troops continue in the southern directions. There are certain successes, in particular in the Novodanilivka-Novoprokopivka direction. Now Ukrainian forces are anchored on the achieved boundaries. But, according to the press center of the Southern Defense Forces, it cannot be claimed that the

breakthrough of the first line of defense of the russians in the south is a final victory, after which there will be no resistance. russians have a place to retreat and a place to entrench.

- In the Kherson sector, more than 25 localities suffered from enemy artillery shelling. At the same time, the Ukrainian Defence Forces continue to conduct offensive operations in the Melitopol sector, consolidating their positions and conducting counter-battery operations.
- In the north, the russia maintains a military presence in the areas bordering Ukraine, keeping in the Bryansk, Kursk, and Belgorod of russian federation regions three groups of troops covering the state border with the aim of restraining Ukrainian troops and preventing their transfer to areas of active hostilities. The russians also continue shelling populated areas from the territory of the russian federation and carry out sabotage and reconnaissance activities in violation of the State Border of Ukraine.
- On the night of 31 August - September 1, 2023, russians fired Kalibr cruise missiles. Two missiles were launched from the Black Sea (near Feodosiia, the Crimea). One missile was destroyed, and the other hit a private facility in Vinnytsia region [central Ukraine]. The missile strike damaged property and private cars. The wounded are being treated.
- On the afternoon of September 1, russian forces shelled the city of Kherson with mortars. They hit a private house, killing a man.
- On August 31, the russian army fired artillery at the city of Nikopol, Dnipropetrovsk region. The Regional Military Administration reported that the projectiles damaged 4 private houses, an outbuilding, 2 power lines, and a gas pipeline. People survived. Also, russian frsecs attacked the center of Kupiansk in the Kharkiv region, wounding a man.
