Status of the Ukrainian nuclear power plants and the nuclear industry of Ukraine

- According to SE NNEGC Energoatom, on October 10, 2023 power units of Ukrainian nuclear power plants, which are located on the territory controlled by Ukraine, worked to meet the needs of the population and the country's economy.

Current situation on Zaporizhzhya NPP

- According to the SE NNEGC Energoatom as of October 10, 2023, the Zaporizhzhya NPP received power for its in-house needs from the energy system of Ukraine. As of 08:00 on October 10, 2023, the radiation state at the Zaporizhzhya NPP was within the current norms. SE NNEGC Energoatom reports that as of 08:00 on October 10, the water level in the cooling pond of Zaporizhzhya NPP was 15.75 m. The situation remains stable and under control.
- Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskyy promised that Ukrainian forces would not directly attack the temporarily occupied Zaporizhzhyy NPP during the counteroffensive. The head of the IAEA, Raphael Grossi, told about this in an interview with The Guardian. The head of the IAEA is concerned that the Zaporizhzhya NPP could be involved in hostilities between the two sides but insisted that he had received a commitment from the Ukrainian leader. "President Zelenskyy personally assured me that they will not directly bomb or shell it," Grossi said. According to the head of the IAEA, Zelenskyy told him that "all other options are under consideration" in terms of releasing the station. Read more: IAEA rotated its representatives at Zaporizhzhya NPP. Grossi added that the danger is that "anything can happen at any moment" given the current military situation.

Current situation on Chernobyl NPP and in the Exclusion Zone

- On October 10, 2023, the radiation situation at the ChNPP site was without changes. The monitored parameters of the equipment were within the boundaries set by the technological regulations. Operating personnel continues to ensure nuclear and radiation safety.

War in Ukraine

- On October 10, 2023, is the 594 day of the resistance of Ukraine to the Russian military invasion.
- According to the General Staff of the Armed Forces of Ukraine, the defense forces of Ukraine continue their offensive in the Melitopol and Bakhmut directions, in the east and south of Ukraine they hold back the Russians. Last day, 108 combat clashes took place. Enemy attacks were repulsed in 5 directions.

- russians are trying to find weak points in defense of the city of Avdiivka in Donetsk region [eastern Ukraine]. They are trying to encircle the city and drag the reserves of the Armed Forces to the Avdiivka direction.
- Ukrainian defenders also successfully repelled more than 10 enemy attacks in the areas of Maiinka and Krasnohorivka in Donetsk region. In the Shakhtarsk direction, the enemy conducted unsuccessful offensives. In the Zaporizhzhya direction, the Ukrainian Armed Forces improved the tactical situation west of the settlement Robotyne and continue to hold back the enemy in the areas of settlements Inzhenerne and Verbove. The situation is currently under control, fighting continues. According to the General Staff of the Armed Forces of Ukraine advance in the area of Verbove "is not as big as we would like", but it is quite important in tactical terms and for further actions.
- In addition, the russians, with the forces of the Sixth Army, are trying to conduct offensives in the Kupiansk direction, but the Armed Forces of Ukraine are actively holding the defense and do not give the enemy any chance.
- According to the National Resistance Centre, russian subversive reconnaissance groups have become more active on border with Sumy region on the north of Ukraine. Special units of the Main Directorate of the General Staff of the russian Armed Forces arrived in Belgorod region [russian federation] to organize sabotage on the territory of Ukraine. The National Intelligence Centre notes that the Belgorod underground records the movement of russian units.
- The General Staff of the Armed Forces of Ukraine released information on the russian occupiers' strikes on the territory of Ukraine on October 10, 2023. russians conducted 2 missile and 62 air strikes, fired 30 MLRS attacks.
