## Status of the Ukrainian nuclear power plants and the nuclear industry of Ukraine

- According to SE NNEGC Energoatom, on November 24-25, power units of Ukrainian nuclear power plants, which are located on the territory controlled by Ukraine, worked to meet the needs of the population and the country's economy.

## Current situation on Zaporizhzhya NPP

- According to the SE NNEGC Energoatom as of November 24-25, 2023, the Zaporizhzhya NPP received power for its in-house needs from the energy system of Ukraine. As of 08:00 on November 24-25, 2023, the radiation state at the Zaporizhzhya NPP was within the current norms.

## Current situation on Chernobyl NPP and in the Exclusion Zone

- On November 24-25, 2023, the radiation situation at the ChNPP site was without changes. The monitored parameters of the equipment were within the boundaries set by the technological regulations. Operating personnel continues to ensure nuclear and radiation safety.

## War in Ukraine

- On November 25, 2023, is the 640 day of the resistance of Ukraine to the russian military invasion.
- On the night of November 24-25, russia launched a record 75 Shahed kamikaze UAVs to attack Ukraine, 74 of which were shot down. The Air Force of Ukraine clarified that the launches were carried out from two directions: Primorsko-Akhtarsk and Kursk Oblast in russia.
- Air defence systems were responding to the attack in at least six oblasts of Ukraine: Kyiv, Sumy, Dnipropetrovsk, Zaporizhzhya, Mykolaiv and Kirovohrad. A Kh-59 guided missile was also downed in Dnipropetrovsk Oblast. Anti-aircraft missile units, tactical aircraft, mobile fire groups and electronic warfare units were involved in repelling the attack.
- Four private residential houses, an apartment building, several cars and the premises belonging to a business were damaged in Kyiv Oblast in russia's Shahed drone attack on the night of 24-25 November. Five people injured, debris falls in 4 districts of the capital and region. Also, after russia attack overnight 77 residential buildings and 120 institutions were cut off from the power supply in Kyiv.
- russia upgrades Shahed UAVs with carbon to make them less easy to detect – Ukrainian Air Force stated.

- Latvian President Edgars Rinkēvičs, having witnessed russia's largest-ever drone attack on Kyiv, has stated that Ukraine must be provided with more air defence assets. Earlier, Rinkēvičs posted a photo of himself in a Kyiv shelter on the night of 24-25 November as the city faced a massive russian drone attack.
- According the General Staff of the Armed Forces of Ukraine, russians conduct assaults and attacks on 6 fronts. Ukrainian forces are continuing to hold positions on the left bank of the River Dnipro in Kherson Oblast [southern direction]. They have repelled the largest number of attacks on the Avdiivka front [eastern direction]. The russian forces have reduced the number of airstrikes in the hotspots of the contact line in Ukraine, but their infantry activity is still high.
- Over the course of the day, Ukraine's defence forces clashed with russian troops 42 times. russian forces carried out 3 missile strikes and 99 airstrikes and deployed multiple-launch rocket systems (MLRS) 38 times to attack the positions of Ukrainian troops and civilian settlements.
- Lithuania has announced that it will give €2 million to support the Grain From Ukraine initiative to help mitigate threats to food security caused by russia's war of aggression.
- The European Commission will give Ukraine €50 million to repair its ports in the wake of russian attacks in order to facilitate the export of Ukrainian agricultural products to the global market.
