Status of the Ukrainian nuclear power plants and the nuclear industry of Ukraine

- According to the JSC "NNEGC "Energoatom", on February 8-11, 2024 power units of Ukrainian nuclear power plants which are located on the territory controlled by Ukraine worked to meet the needs of the population and the country's economy.
- According to the International Atomic Energy Agency, the IAEA teams at the Rivne, Khmelnytsky, and South Ukraine NPPs as well as the Chernobyl site continue to report that nuclear safety and security is maintained.

Current situation on Zaporizhzhya NPP

- According to the JSC "NNEGC "Energoatom" on February 8-11, 2024, the Zaporizhzhya NPP received power for its in-house needs from the energy system of Ukraine. On February 8-11, 2024, the exposure dose rate of gamma radiation in the area where the Zaporizhzhya NPP complied with current standards.

Current situation on Chernobyl NPP and in the Exclusion Zone

- On February 8-11, 2024, the radiation situation at the ChNPP site was without changes. The monitored parameters of the equipment were within the boundaries set by the technological regulations. Operating personnel continues to ensure nuclear and radiation safety.

War in Ukraine

- On February 11, 2024, is the 718 day of the resistance Ukraine to the Russian military invasion.
- According to the General Staff of the Armed Forces of Ukraine [AFU], in the North in the Volyn and Polissia directions, the operational situation remains without significant changes. In the Siverskyi and Slobozhanskyi directions, Russia maintains a military presence in the border areas, conducts active sabotage activities in order to prevent the transfer of Ukrainian troops to threatening directions, increases the density of mine-explosive barriers along the state border in the Belgorod region [Russian Federation]. On February 9, Russians dropped 7 guided aerial bombs on border communities of the Sumy region [northern Ukraine], three people were killed.
- Situation in the East. Ukrainian defenders repelled enemy attacks in the Kupyansk [Kharkiv region], Lyman [Luhansk region], Bakhmut, Marinka [Donetsk region] sectors. In the Avdiivka sector [Donetsk region], Ukrainian defenders continue to hold back the Russian army, who keeps trying to surround the city of Avdiivka and wants to establish control over logistics routes on the northern flank.
- In the South, in the Zaporizhzhya sector, the Defense Forces also repelled an enemy

attacks near settlement Robotino. In the Kherson sector, the Defense Forces continue to hold their positions and repel the attacks of the occupation forces.

- More than 130 settlements in Chernihiv, Sumy, Kharkiv, Luhansk, Donetsk, Zaporizhzhya, Dnipropetrovsk, Kherson and Mykolaiv regions came under artillery fire.
- On the night of February 9, 2024, russians struck with 16 Shahed-136/131 strike UAVs from Cape Chauda in Crimea and Kursk region of the russian federation. Units of mobile firing groups of the Ukrainian Air Force and Defense Forces were involved in repelling the air attack. As a result of combat operations, 10 'shaheds' were destroyed in Mykolaiv, Kherson and Kharkiv regions. In the evening of February 9, the enemy attacked civilian objects in the village of Velykyi Burluk, Chuhuiv district, Kharkiv region. As noted, the strikes caused fires and damaged the building of a cafe and a medical facility. The total area of the fire was 180 square metres.
- According to the investigation, on February 10, at night, the russian armed forces carried out a massive drone attack on civilian and port infrastructure in Odesa and Podunavia. A technical building of the port infrastructure was damaged in Odesa, and an employee of the company was injured. Three truck drivers were injured in the attack on the Danube port infrastructure. They were taken to hospital with injuries of varying severity.
- As a result of an attack by drones on a gas station in Kharkiv on February 10, fuel was spilled and 14 private houses were set on fire. The attack by enemy drones on Kharkiv killed 7 people, including children.
- On the night of February 12, the russians attacked Ukraine with 17 Shahed-136/131 strike UAVs launched from the Primorsko-Akhtarsk area, an X-59 guided missile (from the TOT of Zaporizhzhya region) and S-300 anti-aircraft guided missiles (from Belgorod region). Units of the mobile fire groups of the Air Force and the Defense Forces of Ukraine were involved in repelling the air attack. As a result of combat operations, 14 "Shaheds" and one X-59 guided missile were destroyed in Khmelnytskyi, Vinnytsia, Kirovohrad, Mykolaiv, Dnipropetrovsk and Zaporizhzhya regions.

On February 10, the night shelling of the city of Kharkiv claimed the lives of seven people. Among them was a family with three children. This was reported by the head of the Kharkiv Regional Military Administration.

As noted, in one of Kharkiv's private residential buildings, a fire killed an entire family of 5 people: a husband and wife and their three children: a seven-year-old, four-year-old, and seven-month-old boy. The fire was caused by a fuel leak, which was followed by a hazardous substance leaking down the street where the residential sector is located. The body of the man was found in the corridor of the house, while the mother and children tried to escape in the bathroom.

In another house, a 66-year-old man and his 65-year-old wife were killed.

On February 9, 2024, Russian military carried out an air strike on the territory of the Sumy district [north of Ukraine] from the territory of the Russian Federation. According to preliminary data, the enemy dropped 7 guided bombs. Three civilians were killed as a result of the enemy attack. Four people were injured.

On February 8, russian troops shelled the settlement of Selydove in the Donetsk region with S-300 missiles and North Korean KN-23 missiles. A 50-year-old woman died as a result of the shelling, her body was removed from the rubble. Seven people were injured. Among them is a 7 ears old boy. At the moment, 53 apartment buildings and 10 private houses, 4 educational institutions, 2 administrative buildings, a private enterprise, and 24 vehicles have been damage.
