Status of the Ukrainian nuclear power plants and the nuclear industry of Ukraine

- According to the JSC "NNEGC "Energoatom", on July 8-9, 2024, power units of Ukrainian nuclear power plants which are located on the territory controlled by Ukraine worked to meet the needs of the population and the country's economy.
- According to the International Atomic Energy Agency [IAEA], the IAEA experts present at the Khelmnytsky, Rivne and South Ukraine Nuclear Power Plants (NPPs) and the Chernobyl site reported that nuclear safety and security are being maintained despite the effects of the ongoing war, including air raid alarms on several days over the week.

Current situation on Zaporizhzhya NPP

- According to the JSC "NNEGC "Energoatom", from July 8-9, 2024, the exposure dose rate of gamma radiation in the area where the Zaporizhzhya NPP is located in the temporarily occupied territories of Ukraine complied with current standards. - Despite the destruction of the Kakhovska hydroelectric power plant dam by Russian occupiers, the situation remains stable and controllable. The water level in the cooling pond of the Zaporizhzhya Nuclear Power Plant is 15.01 m. The water level in the "hot" channel of the Zaporizhzhya Thermal Power Plant, from where, if necessary, the ZNPP rate is fed, is 16.41 m. In the "cold" channel of the Zaporizhzhya Thermal Power Plant, the water level reaches 10.58 m.

Current situation on Chernobyl NPP and in the Exclusion Zone

- On July 8-9, 2024, the radiation situation at the ChNPP site was without changes. The monitored parameters of the equipment were within the boundaries set by the technological regulations. Operating personnel continues to ensure nuclear and radiation safety.

War in Ukraine

- On July 9, 2024, is the 867 day of the resistance Ukraine to the Russian military invasion.
- According to the General Staff of the Armed Forces of Ukraine [AFU], as of 4:00 pm on July 9, 2024, 81 combat engagements took place along the entire frontline.

The Russian invaders are focusing their main efforts on the Pokrovsk direction in Donetsk region [eastern Ukraine], accounting for more than 35 percent of all clashes. As noted, Ukrainian defenders are holding back the onslaught of the occupation forces and inflicting significant losses on the enemy.

- **Situation in the North.** In the border areas of the Sumy and Chernihiv regions, Russia continues to carry out its terrorist attacks with the help of artillery shelling from the territory of the Russian Federation.
- **Situation in Kharkiv region.** At the same time, Ukrainian soldiers have repelled four occupant attacks in the areas of Vovchansk, Starytsia, and Lyptsi, and two more attacks are ongoing. In the Kupiansk direction, the Russian army tried unsuccessfully to storm the positions of Ukrainian units near Berestove and Pishchane four times.
- **Hostilities in the East.** According to the General Staff, the enemy became more active in the Lyman direction. It launched 12 attacks on Ukrainian positions. All the engagements ended without success for the enemy. Russians continue to look for weaknesses in defence in the Siversk direction. The General Staff also emphasises that the number of enemy attacks in the Toretsk direction has increased. Russian military are attacking near populated areas. The Pokrovsk direction witnessed the highest number of combat engagements and have made attempts to push Ukrainian defenders from their positions.
- **Situation in the South.** A firefight continues in the Vremivka direction near Vodiane. The defense forces are taking measures to prevent the occupants from advancing deeper into Ukrainian territory.
- **Situation with shelling of Ukraine.**
- On the morning of July 8, Russian troops carried out a massive missile attack on Ukraine. The invaders fired more than 40 missiles of various types at Ukraine. In particular, they fired at Kyiv, Dnipro, Kryvyi Rih, Sloviansk, and Kramatorsk.
- In Kyiv, residential buildings, infrastructure, and two children's hospitals, including the largest children's hospital in Ukraine, Okhmatdyt, were damaged. Also, during the rocket attack on July 8, the two other medical centers on the left bank of Kyiv were destroyed. Five doctors and two patients died. Also in Kyiv, a residential building in the Shevchenkivskyi district was hit: one entrance was completely destroyed, 12 people died.
- A total number of victims in Kyiv: 34 people were killed, including 4 children, and 120 injured, including 10 children.
- In Kryvyi Rih, a rocket hit a business and residential buildings. According to the latest reports, 11 people were killed and more than 40 others were injured with varying degrees of severity.
- In Dnipro, there were hits in two districts: a service station was damaged in one location, and a high-rise building in the other. One person was reported dead, and there are wounded.
- On July 9, 2024, Russian troops fired on Kramatorsk, Donetsk region resulted in 4 wounded, including one six-year-old child. At least 3 apartment buildings were damaged.
- At night on July 10, 2024 Russian troops attacked Ukraine with one Iskander-M ballistic missile and four Kh-59/Kh-69 guided missiles from the occupied Crimea,



as well as 20 Shahed-131/136 attack UAVs from the Kursk region. As a result of combat operations, 14 "Shaheds" were shot down in the Odesa, Mykolaiv, Kherson, Dnipro, Khmelnytskyi, Cherkasy, Vinnytsia and Rivne regions.

- In particular on the night of July 10, Russian invaders launched a missile attack on the port infrastructure of the Odesa region: 2 killed and 1 wounded. Also, Russian troops attacked an energy facility in the Rivne region with Shaheds. As noted, household and industrial consumers were cut off due to the enemy attack. Currently, the power supply has been restored, emergency restoration works are ongoing.

Strike on Kyiv on July 8: 34 killed, including 4 children, 120 injured, including 10 children. A X-101 missile hit the Okhmatdyt children's hospital while 627 children were there. Currently, 94 children have been transferred from the hospital to other medical institutions in Kyiv. Another 465 children who needed routine treatment have been examined and temporarily discharged home.



On July 8, russians attacked the Northern Mining and Processing Plant in Kryvyi Rih. Metinvest reported 10 dead and more than 40 injured. It is noted that the hostile attack damaged the canteen hall of the plant's administration, and smashed windows. The rubble is currently being cleared.
